Wendy Lee, born December 10th, was an early X-mas bundle for Robt. and Leslie Taylor of 950 LaMonte.


Johnny and Cindy Murphy now hear the pitterpat of little feet with the arrival of Michael Wayne on November 18th.

As you know the city of Houston has enumerable city ordinances concerning a wide vari ety of issues. In the following months the Gazette will review numerous ordinances which are of great interest to our many residents. I f there are any issues which you may feel a particular interest, let Jane Little know. (869 _ 3165). We will follow my and all findings on the matters which are of concern to Garden Oaks residents.

The ordinance highlighted this month deals with dogs " running at large ".

Section 6 - 56 of the City Code states:

" It shall be unlawful for any person owning or having in his possession any dog and to allow such dog to be at large without the owner or person in charge having direct physical control over such dog. "
