BUILDING REPAIR

We will be starting a publicity campaign soon to raise funds as soon as we have a more definite amount. We hope every member of our community will find it important enough to save our building that each one will make a donation.

ORDINANCE OF THE MONTH 36-161 - SWIMMING POOLS (FENCED)

Every person in possession of property, whether owner or tenant, upon which is situated a swimming pool shall at all times maintain a fence, wall, or barrier completely surrounding and enclosing the pool. The fence or enclosure must be a minimum of 4 feet in height and have no openings or gaps any larger than 4 inches. A building or existing wall may serve as part of the enclosure. Gates and doors into the enclosed area must have a self-closing and self-latching device designed to keep the gate or door securely closed at all times. The latching device must be on the upper quarter of the gate.

RECIPE OF THE MONTH LEMON SUPREME CAKE

1 pkg. Lemon Supreme cake mix 1 cup Apricot nectar 3/4 cup oil 1/2 cup sugar 4 eggs OVEN: 325° GLAZE: 1 cup powdered sugar Juice of two lemons

Mix all ingredients except the eggs and glaze. Add eggs one at a time and beat for 1 minute with mixer before adding the next egg. Bake in greased and floured bundt pan for 1 hour in the 325° oven.
