



RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Fruit Pie Winner "83 Garden Oaks Chili Cook Off
Bill and Jackie Hawkins
BERRY MERINGUE PIE
(seedless)

1 c. sugar 4T. Corn Starch 2 c. Berry Juice 3 eggs, seperated 1 T butter 1 t. Almond Extract.

In large glass measuring cup blend sugar and corn starch. Stir in Juice. Microwave on High 3 minutes. Stir. Microwave another 3 minutes. Repeat until mixture begins to thicken. Beat egg yolks. Stir in a small amount of the hot juice mixture then add to juice mixture. Stir in Butter and almond extract. Cool to luke warm. Pour into baked pie shell. Top with meringue made by beating the 3 egg whites until foamy, beat in 1 teaspoon cream of tartar. Add 3 T. sugar a little at a time. Beat just until the egg whites hold soft peaks. Pile on pie and brown lightly in a 375 oven Serves 6 - 8

PIE CRUST (2 single or 1 double crust)

2 1/4 c. flour 1 t. salt 3/4 c. shortening milk to moisten

Cut shortening into flour and salt. Stir in just enough milk to make mixture hold together. Handle gently. Roll out onto floured board. Fit loosely into pan. Trim, flute, and prick. Bake at 375° til golden brown.


