#### BREAKFAST PIE from Pat Eckert

9" pie shell, unbaked 6 Oz. sausage, cooked ( drained and crumbled )  
4 Oz. Mozzarella cheese or Brick cheese 4 eggs, beaten  
3/4 cup milk salt and pepper

Preheat oven to 375 degrees . Line unbaked pie shell with half of the cheese cut into strips. Top with cooked sausage, cover with remaining cheese. Combine eggs, milk, salt and pepper and beat well. Pour over the cheese. Bake for 25 - 30 minutes.

#### ZESTY SHRIMP DIP from Margaret Mills

1 3 oz. pkg. cream cheese	1 8 oz. carton of sour cream cheese
1 tsp. of lemon juice	1 packet of Italian dressing mix
1 Tbsp. finely chopped green pepper	1 can shrimp , rinsed and drained

Beat cream cheese until light and fluffy. Add remaining ingredients. Chill and serve with vegetables, crackers, or chips.

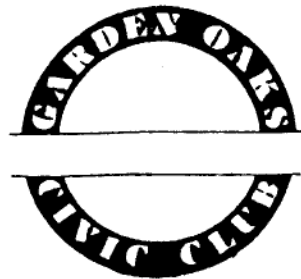
