**ORDER AUTHORIZING EMPLOYMENT OF ROBERTS MARKEL  
WEINBERG BUTLER HAILEY, PC AS SPECIAL COUNSEL**

The Court, having considered the Application for Authority to Employ Roberts Markel Weinberg Butler Hailey, PC (the "Application"), is of the opinion that the requested relief is in the best interest of the estate; that Roberts Markel Weinberg Butler Hailey, PC ("Roberts Markel") represents no interest adverse to the estate and is a disinterested person within the definition of 11 U.S.C. § 101(14); and that the Application should be approved. It is therefore

**ORDERED** that Roberts Markel is employed pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 327 to provide all necessary legal services to the Debtor in this case as set forth in the Application, effective November 1, 2018, Sipra Boyd is designated as attorney in charge for the representation by Roberts Markel of the Debtor in this case. Subject to further approval by this Court, Roberts Markel shall be compensated in accordance with its normal billing practices and reimbursed for its necessary expenses incurred in representing the Debtor in this case as set forth in the Application. The Debtor is authorized to provide Roberts Markel a \$7,500.00 retainer.

**ALL RATES, FEES AND EXPENSES ARE SUBJECT TO COURT APPROVAL.**

All allowed fees and expenses of Roberts Markel shall constitute administrative expenses. All applications for compensation shall be filed with the Court in accordance with the Bankruptcy Code, the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure and the rules of this Court.
