

CRITTER CORNER By David T. Horsley

Mushrooms! We have mushrooms. All that rain at the end of July and the first part August has a magical effect on whatever spores slumbered under our St. Augustine. Throughout the neighborhood you can see single mushrooms, clusters of mushrooms, occasionally whole families of mushrooms.

But by far the neatest sight is the fabled "fairy circle", a circular arrangement of mushrooms six or eight feet in diameter. We have a couple of those on our street. Now let me think — I used to know why mushrooms grow in a circle that way. The ancients belived that at night the fairies would come out and dance in a circle, so the next morning the mushrooms grew to mark the path the fairies trod. We now know better, and understand it in terms of rhizomes or rhizoids or some such, little white roots radiating out from a central point and stopping to sprout a mushroom at the end of each "spoke". I think I like the fairy version better, don't you?

The hummingbirds have arrived in Garden Oaks right on time, the first week of August. Usually the Mississippi kites are about a week behind the hummers, but so far nobody has sighted one.

This is the time of the summer when the squirrels stop eating Meow Mix catfood from our cat's bowl and begin munching on pine cones the way God meant for them to. This year's crop of pine cones promises to be a beauty, but right now they are still a little green and closed up tight. The squirrels must really love those pine seeds to fight their way through a green pine cone. Ouch!

Speaking of nuts, the pecan crop is also looking good. The trees are bent way over from the weight of those nuts. I guess the bugs must have left us a few after all.

Back to the mushrooms for a minute; do you know exactly which ones are edible and which are poisonous? Neither do I, so I am plucking them as fast as they appear and throwing them in the trash. Otherwise, they will become a meal for my son, who would poison himself without ever giving it a thought. If you have small eat-everything children at your place, you might want to keep the mushrooms harvested in advance of them.


