GAZETTE DELIVERY

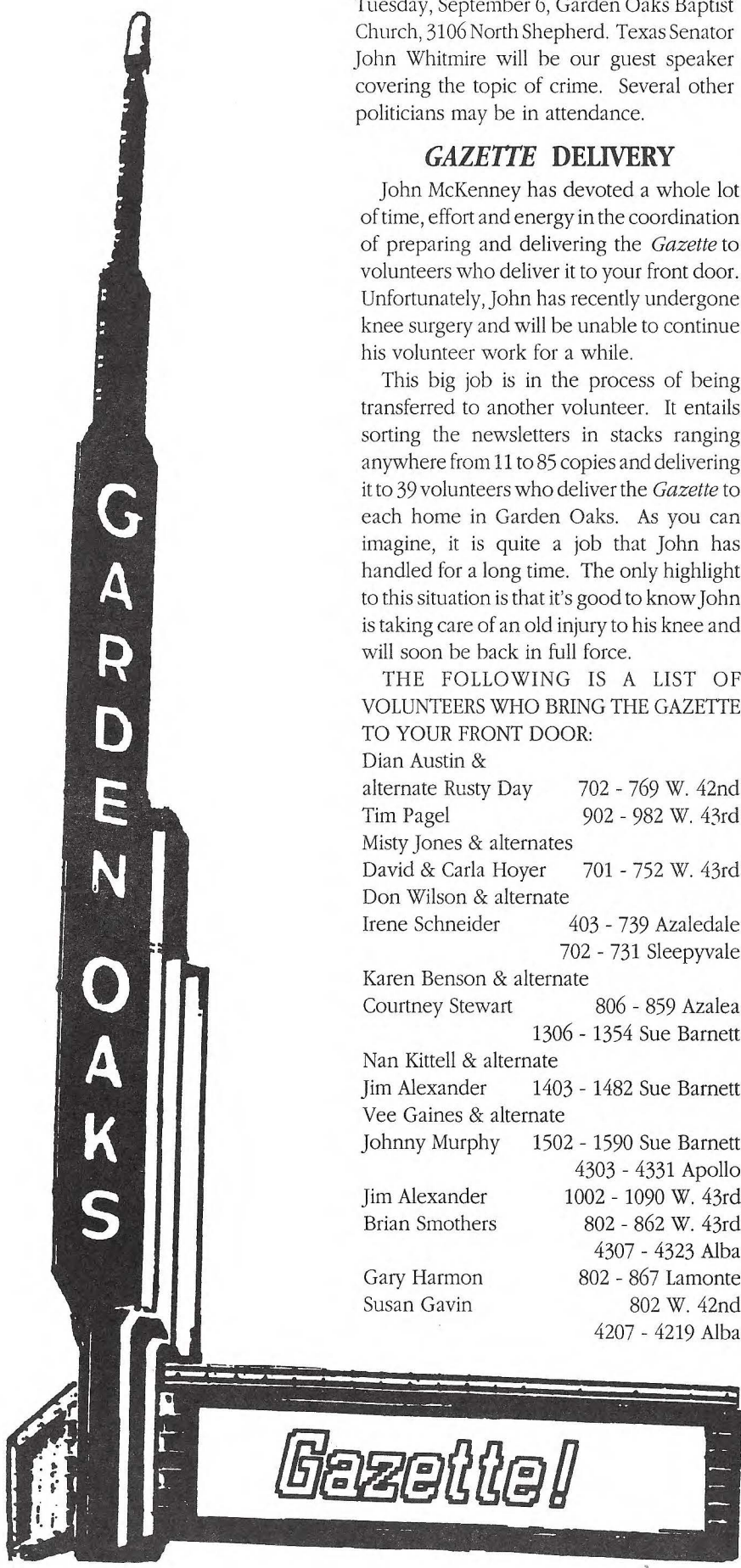
