**DECLARATION OF RANDY WILLIAMS, TRUSTEE
IN SUPPORT OF OBJECTION TO CLAIM #293
FILED BY CHERYL LUCK**

I, Randy Williams, Chapter 7 Trustee of Garden Oaks Maintenance Organization, Inc., (“Trustee”), declare as follows:


The Debtor filed a voluntary chapter 11 petition on April 11, 2018. The Debtor was unable to confirm a plan, and the case was converted to a chapter 7 on June 6, 2019. I was appointed Chapter 7 Trustee.

To the best of my knowledge, information, and belief, the assertions made in the Objection are accurate. In evaluating the Claims, the Reviewing Parties reviewed the Debtor’s books and records, each of the relevant Proofs of Claim, the supporting documentation provided by each claimant, and the claims docket in this case.

During the review of the filed proofs of claim, it was determined that the claim filed by Cheryl Luck (Claim #293) does not clearly indicate that the claimant actually paid any fees. In addition, the Debtor’s records do not indicate that Ms. Luck actually paid any fees. Finally, if the fees were paid by the claimant, they were paid voluntarily, not giving rise to any equitable claim for relief. Claim #293 should be disallowed.
