# Garden Oaks Civic Club Minutes

Tuesday, October 4, 2025 @ Great Heights Brewing

The meeting was called to order at 7:17pm by President Mike Stephens.

A motion to accept the minutes as written from the September 2025 meeting was made by Mike. The motion was seconded and approved.

Thomas Wheaton, Director of Communications from CM Mario Castillo's office, (District H) said concerns about solid waste collection are being addressed, and overall improvements are occurring with regards to maintaining collection schedules. If residents are still encountering collection delays, report them to 311 and also email complaints to the District H office. He announced that there is a tree giveaway at the North Side Facility on November 15. Trees will be available in both 5- and 15-gallon size containers. Sign up for the trees on District H social media pages or website via QR codes.

This month, the guest speaker was Dr. Rashada Abraham Brown, the principal of Garden Oaks Montessori Magnet school. She has been at the school for 4 years, serving the most recent 2 years as principal. She stated that pre-K and Kindergarten enrollment

is up, with more neighborhood families included in the student population. She mentioned that despite HISD budget shortfalls, parent and faculty involvement is strong, with both parents and teachers stepping up to help with ground maintenance and other school needs. There will be a Fall Festival on November 15, which will include a pancake breakfast.

Treasurer Brian Rabe stated that all is still on course with the 2025 budget, despite a slight deficit. He also announced that there will be no increase in Civic Club dues for 2026. Brian stated that the 2026 civic club budget is out, of which he left copies of on the tables in the meeting, and that a vote on the 2026 budget will take place at the December civic club meeting. He also communicated that the final approval for the new neighborhood signage is still in progress with the City of Houston.

Social Chair Emily Stephens discussed the upcoming Azalea Street Fest, which will take place on November 15 from 4:00-7:00pm. She declared that so far \$20,100 has been raised by sponsorships alone. Tickets can be purchased on the Garden Oaks social media pages, website, or neighborhood signs via QR codes.

Bill Shaughnessy, the Chairman of the Nominating Committee, declared that he had formed a prestigious committee to present
